POLICY



Privacy

Southern Districts Touch Association (SDTA) is committed to the protection of members' personal information. Any personal information members provide to SDTA will be used for those purposes which the information was gathered for, as stated, and related purposes which can be reasonably expected.

SDTA will not disclose any personally identifiable information obtained from members to other parties or for purposes other than those stated above, unless members provide written consent, with the following exceptions:

- Where there are grounds to believe that disclosure is required in order to prevent a threat to health or life;
- Where SDTA suspects that unlawful activity is or has been engaged in, such personal information may be used to investigate the suspected unlawful activity; or
- The use is authorised by law or reasonably necessary to enforce the law.

Information that members provide through various means will be kept safe and secure within SDTA.

SDTA may also use members' personal information for the purposes of direct marketing in relation to promotional activities where it is impracticable to obtain prior written consent. However, when SDTA does this, it will provide an express option for members to decline receiving any further marketing communications from SDTA, via an opt out mechanism.

SDTA will only send members emails if they have elected to receive such emails or if they are in response to an email that has been received.
